

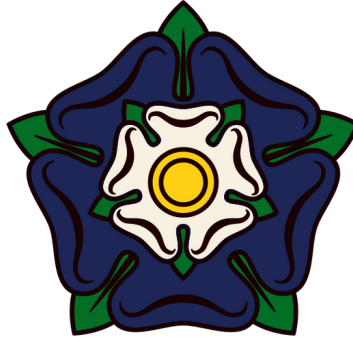

Immigration Reform Act 2022

A legislative act to establish a clearer and more efficient immigration policy across Gwentia.

BE IT ENACTED by the Lord Chancellor and the people of the Commonwealth of Gwentia, as follows:-

PART I CITIZENSHIP

1) Establishment of Citizenship

(1) Citizens are individuals that have been granted legal rights to reside within the Commonwealth of Gwentia.

(2) Those without the status of a citizen may gain it by -

(a) Requesting citizenship from the Lord Chancellor.

(1) The Lord Chancellor may see fit to permit the granting of citizenship or disallow it.

(b) Being granted citizenship directly from the Lord Chancellor.

2) Immigration

(1) The Lord Chancellor may promote or demote citizens at their will using what they have at their disposal.

3) Amendments to the Great Charter

(1) Insert at the end of section 3 in the Great Charter -

“(d) Only Citizens are allowed to vote in Gwentian elections.”

(2) Amend section 3 (b) of the Great Charter to read -

“Candidates for the Gwentian Parliament must have attained the age of fourteen, candidates must also be citizens of the Gwentian Commonwealth.”
